Rosemaling Class

Marilyn Hansen will be conducting a rosemaling class in Walla Walla; Saturday and Sunday, August 4th and 5th, from 9:00am until about 3:30pm each day. If you plan to attend church services during that time, come after. If you are only able to attend one of the days, the price will be adjusted.

Where: The Rancho Villa Recreation Hall on the Dalles Military Road, just past the Pepsi plant. We'll have a sign out to help you locate it.

Cost: The total cost will be about \$75. The cost of the 2-day workshop is \$50.

Additional charges will be:

- Brushes (#4 flat and #1 liner Loew-Cornell) \$10 (\$5 apiece)
- Board to paint on (background prepped)\$7 or Round wooden plate (prepped) for more experienced \$10
- Use of Marilyn's paint and supplies \$7

If you have good quality brushes of your own and/or oil paints and other supplies, and wish to use them; you'll only need to buy the prepped board or plate. If you don't have these supplies, it's better to use Marilyn's so you don't spend money on materials that may be unnecessary or inappropriate for the project. She will give us a list of essential supplies to purchase if we are interested in continuing to paint. Other things that will be valuable to have along are a paint shirt to protect clothing, and a 14"x14" pizza box (available at Little Ceasar's Pizza for a small charge) to protect your project in transit.
