Sankthans, or the official abbreviation St. Hans, or Jonsok is June 24th, but Norwegians are fonder of Eve's, (note Christmas Eve equals Christmas to Norwegians), so it is celebrated on June 23rd. The origin of St. Hans is from pagan days, when summer solstice was celebrated. When Norway was christened the Church knew it was easier to give any holiday a religious reason than to try to do away with it. So they named it Jonsok, for Johannes døperen, John the Baptist, in his memory. Hans is also short for Johannes, and ergo St. Hans. This day was an official holiday until 1770.

Two of our members served on committees; Nancy Carrs Roach served on the Resolutions committee and Karen Aanes served on the Reports committee.

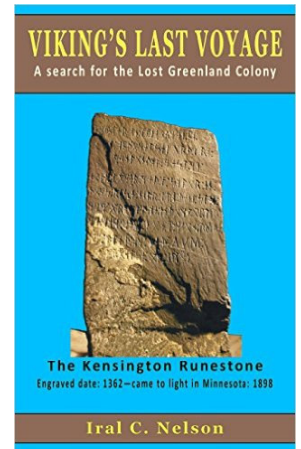
We also have 2 members returning to the District Board; Ron Rolla will be serving as Zone 5 Director again, and Nancy Holter is the District Publicity/Social Director.
