Sankthans, or the official abbreviation St. Hans, or Jonsok is June 24th, but Norwegians are more fond of Eve's, (note Christmas Eve equals Christmas to Norwegians), so it is celebrated on June 23rd. The origin of St. Hans is from pagan days, when summer solstice was celebrated. When Norway was christened the Church knew it was easier to give any holiday a religious reason than to try to do away with it. So they named it Jonsok, for Johannes døperen, John the Baptist, in his memory. Hans is also short for Johannes, and ergo St. Hans. This day was an official holiday until 1770. (Source:

## NORDIC AMERICAN VOICES ORAL HISTORY PROGRAM PRESENTATION

Sol-Land Lodge is pleased to welcome the Nordic American Voices (NAV) oral history program from the Nordic Heritage Museum in Ballard to our **Friday May 20th meeting & Syttende Mai celebration**. Mari-Ann Kind Jackson is the Chair of the NAV Steering Committee. She will be sharing with us the illustrated story about this special ongoing project.

NAV began as an effort to gather the immigrant stories of a generation of Ballard residents who were born in Scandinavia. Today, NAV builds upon the expertise gained in that 1999-2000 Vanishing Generation Project when more than 40 volunteers recorded 123 interviews. Two books and two documentary movies have been produced by the NAV based on immigrant experiences and recollections from life in Scandinavia during World War 2 through to the present day in our Pacific Northwest.

#### Simple Shrimp Canapés

Serves 4

##### Ingredients:

16 slices bread  
1/2 cup mayo  
1/4 cup butter, softened  
1 small jar capers  
1 lemon, sliced in half moons  
4 large sprigs fresh dill  
20 boiled, cold shrimp, preferably still in the shell or head on

##### Method:

Boil the shrimp. Mine were jumbo and took 7-8 minutes. (Small shrimp will only need 3-4 minutes). Shock in ice water to keep them from overcooking. Drain.  
Lay out all ingredients in a DIY spread. While it's not required, feel free to cut bread into small rounds to up the "cute factor." Scraps may be used in overnight french toast.  
Be sure to provide plenty of napkins, sparkling water, and enough smiles to light up the room.
